Aafiya Imaging and Diagnostic Centre (AIDC), has added a new mammography unit to its facilities at the Al Wadi Commercial Centre in Q'urm. Coinciding with the breast cancer awareness month, the new unit was inaugurated by Yuthar al Rawahy, founder and chairperson of National Association of Cancer Awareness (NACA), on Thursday.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr Hiral Jerajani Kamath, founder and radiologist, AIDC, said, "The mammography unit will play a big role in the early detection of breast cancers. It also brings to fore the advice of regular

check-ups from doctors and medical experts, who have, time and again, exhorted women to do a mammography and rule out the onset of the disease, especially since the risk of breast cancer is known to increase with age."
